## RESPONSE TO REQUEST FOR INFORMATION<sup>1</sup> RFP-2026-JUD-3/VSS BID NO. 42600006 "KOTTEN TINIAN SECURITY CAMERA EQUIPMENT AND INSTALLATION FOR THE NMI JUDICIARY" OCTOBER 28, 2025

- 1. Response to #2 if the testers to be used must have current factory certification. In order to meet TIA/EIA 568 standards. A test analyzer must be calibrated to meet TIA/EIA standards, as the standards require that all test equipment be calibrated according to the manufacturer's recommendations before performing tests. Calibration is necessary to establish a baseline for accurate measurements and to ensure the installed cabling link meets the specified performance requirements, please confirm.
  - Answer ("A"): Due to the scale of this project, the minimum requirement is for the use of a certified test analyzer for testing. Self-calibration of the certified test analyzer will suffice. Proposers are not restricted from presenting a current factory certification for the testing.
- 2. Response to #3 does not require a Certified Network Technician. If the bidders are required to submit a "Signed Certified Cable Test Report", wouldn't the government want the technician who did the testing to be certified in the network infrastructure to meet TIA/EIA-568 standards, please confirm.
  - (A): Due to the scale of this project, the minimum requirement is to provide an electronic test report for each cable run using a certified cable analyzer, with results passing applicable standards. Proposers are not restricted from presenting a certification for network technician.
