**Technical & Scope Inquiries**

**3. Network Video Recorder (NVR) Architecture and Channel Capacity**

- **Reference:** Section III.A.1.a.3 (NVR Specifications) & Section III.A.1.b.3 (NVR Installation)
- **Question:** The RFP specifies the procurement of a new NVR system supporting up to 32 cameras (with expansion licenses) and integration with the Judiciary's existing Bosch DIVAR IP All-in-One 5000. Given that the new deployment entails 67 total cameras, please clarify whether the contractor is expected to supply multiple new 32-channel NVR units to support the full count of 67 new cameras, or if the remaining camera load is to be recorded directly onto the existing Bosch DIVAR IP 5000 unit. If the latter, what is the currently available (unlicensed/unused) channel capacity on the existing unit?

Answer (“A”): The RFP does not provide a specific number of NVRs. The Offerors shall propose the NVR(s), licenses, and related equipment necessary to meet the minimum specifications and system requirements in Sections (III)(A)(1)(a)(3) and (III)(A)(1)(b)(3), including the required 30-day retention period. The proposed solution must accommodate all existing and new cameras, including the six (6) additional elevator cameras for future inclusion, and identify how the cameras will be distributed across the existing and proposed NVR(s).

**4. Video Retention and Storage Sizing Parameters**

- **Reference:** Section III.A.1.a.3.i.c & Section III.A.1.b.3.ii
- **Question:** The Scope of Work requires configuring NVR storage to maintain a minimum retention period of 30 days based on 12 hours of continuous recording and 12 hours of motion-activated recording daily. To ensure accurate storage calculation and proper selection of the pre-installed hard drive capacity (8TB, 16TB, or 36TB), what are the Judiciary's required recording parameters regarding resolution (e.g., native sensor resolution vs. 1080p stream), frame rate (FPS), and video compression standards (e.g., H.264 vs. H.265)?

A: The Judiciary’s required recording parameters is the native sensor resolution at 30 fps. The Offeror shall determine the appropriate video compression solution based on its professional expertise and findings from the onsite inspection of the existing system.

**5. Scope of Future Elevator Camera Expansion**

- **Reference:** Section III.A.1.a.4.ii
- **Question:** The RFP notes that the system must support future expansion for up to six (6) elevator cameras to be procured at a later date. Please confirm whether the contractor's scope under this RFP is strictly limited to provisioning system software licenses and network switch ports, or if the contractor is required to furnish and pull traveling network cables / elevator shafts cabling during this contract phase.

A: Offerors shall provide provisioning software licenses only.

## **6. Exterior Camera Mounting Locations and Infrastructure**

- **Reference:** Section III.A.1.b.2 (Outdoor Security Cameras and CAT6 Cables)

- **Question:** The solicitation requires the installation of seven (7) outdoor security cameras across the Guma' Hustisia and OAPS facilities. Please clarify if all exterior cameras will be mounted directly to the main building structures (e.g., exterior walls, fascia, or soffits). If any cameras are to be mounted on detached structures (such as parking lot light poles, gatehouses, or perimeter fencing), please specify the quantity, the required mounting methods, and whether existing underground conduit is available for these cable runs.

A: Exterior cameras will be mounted to the Judiciary's building structure.

## **7. Existing Network Switches and PoE Power Budget**

- **Reference:** Section III.A.2.b (Power)

- **Question:** The solicitation requires cameras to be powered via the Judiciary's existing PoE-enabled switches and directs the vendor to identify whether supplemental PoE injectors will be necessary. Could the Judiciary provide the make, model numbers, available port counts, and current PoE power budgets (in Watts) of the existing switches located within each designated network room?

A: The information below provides information about the existing switches:

1. Main Hub Room 1st FLR - Ubiquiti UniFi Switch Pro 48 PoE (USW-Pro-48-PoE) 6 units installed; total usage is less than 50 watts. Port availability is adjustable, with 40% inactive.
2. Superior 2nd FLR - Ubiquiti UniFi Switch Pro 48 PoE (USW-Pro-48-PoE). 3 units installed, total usage is less than 50 watts. Port availability is adjustable, with 40% inactive.
3. Supreme 1st FLR - Ubiquiti UniFi Switch Pro 48 PoE (USW-Pro-48-PoE). 2 units installed, total usage is less than 50 watts. Port availability is adjustable, with 40% inactive.
4. SSZ - Ubiquiti UniFi Switch Pro 48 PoE (USW-Pro-48-PoE) 1 unit installed; total usage is less than 50 watts. Port availability is adjustable, with 40% inactive.
5. Office of Adult Probation - Ubiquiti UniFi Switch Pro 48 PoE (USW-Pro-48-PoE) 1 unit installed; total usage is less than 50 watts. Port availability is adjustable, with 40% inactive.
6. Basement - Ubiquiti UniFi Switch Pro 48 PoE (USW-Pro-48-PoE) 1 unit installed; total usage is less than 50 watts. Port availability is adjustable, with 40% inactive.

## **8. Monitoring Station Displays**

- **Reference:** Section III.A.1.a.3.i.f & Section III.A.1.b.3.i

- **Question:** The NVR specifications require three 4K display outputs (1x DisplayPort, 2x HDMI) for viewing and management at the Marshals Service Division office. Is the contractor required to supply new commercial-grade 4K display monitors and mounting hardware as part of this proposal, or will the NVR connect to existing Judiciary monitors?

A: The NVR shall connect to existing monitors.

## **9. Request for RFI Deadline Extension**

- **Reference:** Section II.C (Contact)

- **Question:** The current deadline to submit written questions is Wednesday, September 2, 2026, at 5:00 p.m. ChST. If the Judiciary grants our request for an additional site assessment on September 2 (as requested in Question 1), will the procurement office also consider extending the RFI deadline by a few days (e.g., to Friday, September 4, 2026) to allow prospective proposers adequate time to compile and submit any technical questions that arise during that site visit?

A: The contact deadline shall be extended until 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, September 16, 2026, Chamorro Standard Time to accommodate inquiries during the additional site visits that were accommodated in Addendum No. 1 of this RFP.
