1. Request for Additional Technical Site Survey

- **Reference:** Section II.B (Mandatory Pre-Submission Conference & Site Visits)
- **Question:** To permit technical project engineers to accurately measure conduit runs, inspect TR/closet rack elevations, and assess ceiling pathway accessibility, will the Judiciary permit prospective offerors to conduct an additional technical site survey on Wednesday, September 2, 2026?

Answer (“A”): The Judiciary is willing to accommodate additional site visit requests from qualified prospective proposers between Tuesday, September 8, 2026, through Friday, September 11, 2026, during the Judiciary’s normal business hours, excluding holidays and observed austerity hours. - **Question:** To ensure precise estimation of CAT6 cable pathways, pathway fill ratios, conduit trade sizes, and core drill requirements, will the Judiciary provide architectural floor plans or existing as-built security layouts for the Guma' Hustisia (Basement, Level 1, Level 2) and the OAPS facility?
